IMPORTANT NOTICES

Pease make sure that you let your water drip. We are expecting some very cold temperatures.

Please make sure that you place all your bulk trash in the area that is designated in the back of the complex. Please do not leave trash at the dumpsters.

Please make sure that you only have outside furniture on your porches. Please make sure that you do not have any inside furniture left outside. For outside plants that are on your porch, please make sure that they are maintained.

All children playing outside need to be supervised by an adult. Parents and/or Guardians will be held responsible for their children's behavior and actions.

As stated in House Rule 29, Section A: All residents' motorized vehicle(s) parked at this property must be registered with the apartment property office. Vehicles not registered with management may be towed.

REGENCY RESIDENTS ONLY

The gates at Regency Place will be operational by December 31st.

Residents with registered car decals will receive an adhesive sticker to place in their front window to enter and exit the gate.

Residents will receive further information on how to obtain an adhesive sticker for their vehicles.

If the gate is damaged by a resident or a guest of a resident, the cost of the gate's repair will be incurred. If the incident is unreported to the property management office, the head of household will be held responsible and will receive a termination of tendency or lease non-renewal for damage or destruction of property.

The cameras are working, and the property is under video surveillance at all times.

MAKE RENTAL PAYMENTS ONLINE WITH RENTCAFE



All rental payments **must** be made online. Please prepare for this change by signing up for our online portal using the following instructions:

- 1. Call the leasing office for your Registration Code
- 2. Scan the QR code below using your smartphone or visit the Resident login section at www.rentcafe.com
- 3. Select "Click Here to Register" link
- 4. Search by zip code 31313 or the property name
- 5. Have your full legal name, phone number, and email address
- 6. Create a password and select a security question
- 7. Make sure you verify terms and conditions

Any tenant who is having trouble setting up an account may have a prior RentCafe'. Several factors that may cause a registration issue:

- 1. Demographics do not match. (ex. email, phone number)
- 2. A previous account with another community
- 3. A balance due or credit on account.
